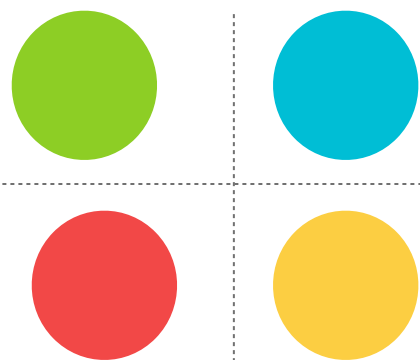

PROJECT #2: ATMOSPHERIC PERSPECTIVE

Create a simple line drawing using pencil then a waterproof marker on a plain piece of paper. You can color the artwork with either watercolor paint, markers or colored pencils.

Use the squares in the worksheet to develop your array of colors going from light to dark. If using watercolor paint, add water to make a color lighter. Add blue or brown to make a color darker. Once you have your colors, select areas of the drawing to paint the dark colors and the light colors.

Guideline:

Light colors in the distance (near the top of the paper)

Medium colors in the middle near the horizon line

Dark colors near the front or bottom of paper.
