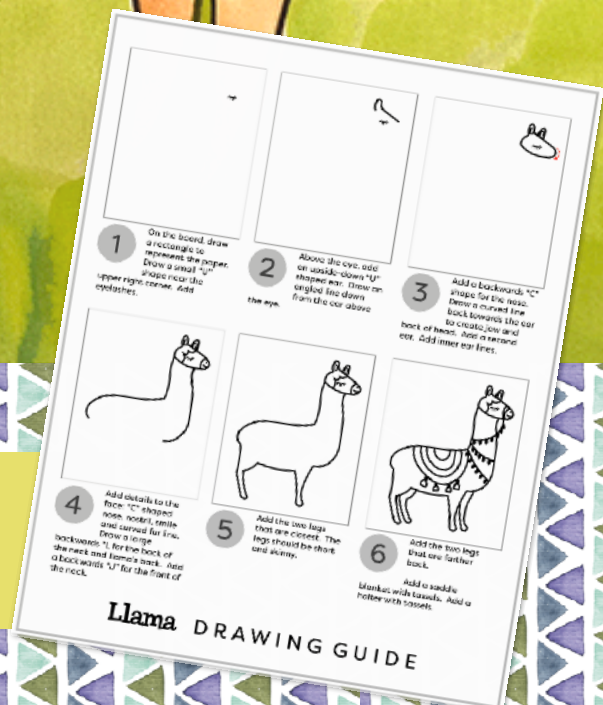

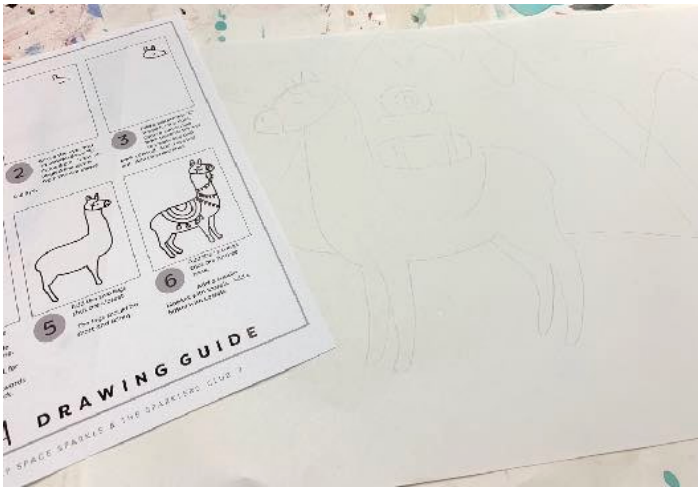

LOVE LIFE LLAMA ART



Using the llama drawing guide, draw the llama in pencil on a sheet of 12" x 18" paper.

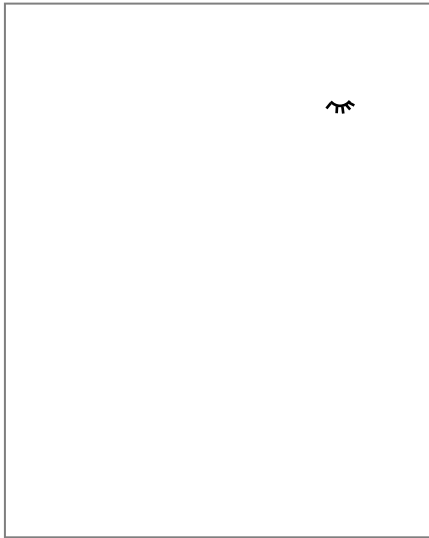
Trace over pencil lines, add details, and add a background with a waterproof marker.



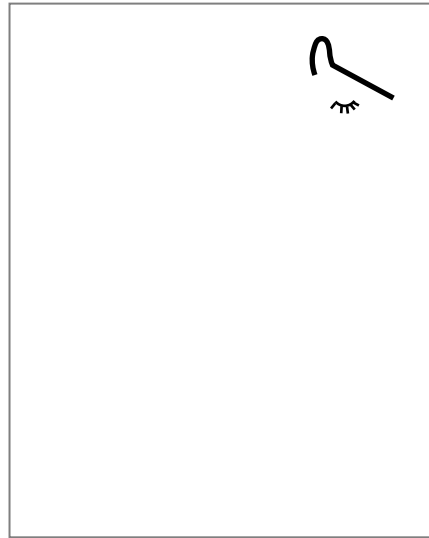
Paint background with cake tempera paints or colored pencils. Use colored markers, crayons, paint markers, etc to color in details of llama blanket, decorations and packs.

Use chalk pastel to add low level clouds.

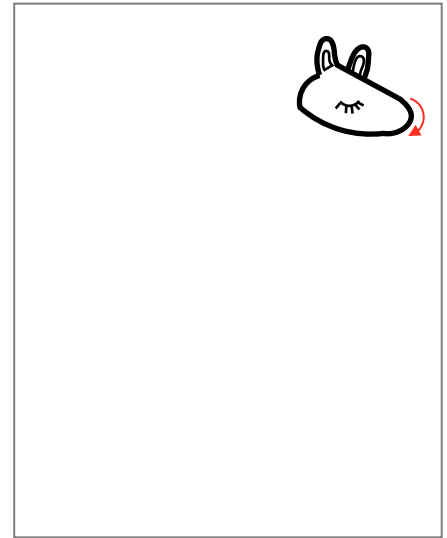




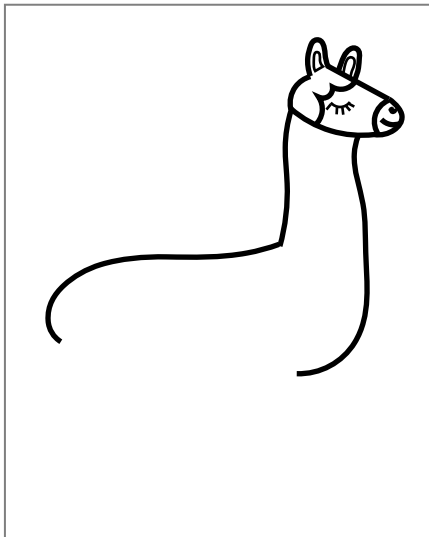
1 On the board, draw a rectangle to represent the paper. Draw a small "U" shape near the upper right corner. Add eyelashes.



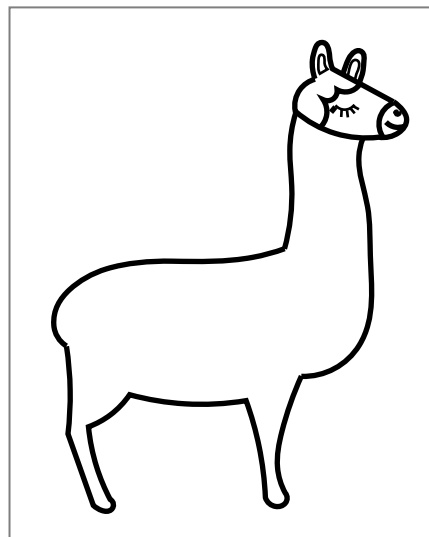
2 Above the eye, add an upside-down "U" shaped ear. Draw an angled line down from the ear above the eye.



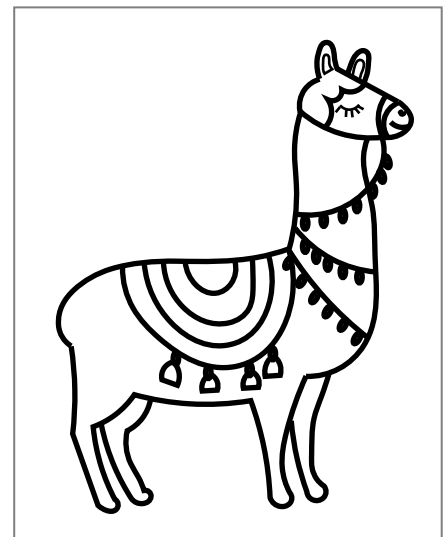
3 Add a backwards "C" shape for the nose. Draw a curved line back towards the ear to create jaw and back of head. Add a second ear. Add inner ear lines.



4 Add details to the face: "C" shaped nose, nostril, smile and curved fur line. Draw a large backwards "L" for the back of the neck and llama's back. Add a backwards "J" for the front of the neck.



5 Add the two legs that are closest. The legs should be short and skinny.



6 Add the two legs that are further back. Add a saddle blanket with tassels. Add a halter with tassels.

I CAN STATEMENTS

- Today I will learn about LINE, so that I CAN follow directions to draw a LLAMA. I'll know I have it when my llama is large, taking up most of the space of the paper.
- Today I will learn about PROPORTION, so that I CAN create a LLAMA by drawing its head and adding the rest of the body IN PROPORTION WITH the head.
